A new scholarship program is now available to young African women and men to study in Canada in a **Master's degree in public administration, public policy or public finance**.

The **2015 Competition** is open to candidates from **South Africa and Senegal***. The deadline to apply for the 2015 academic year is **April 26, 2015**.

The ALT Scholarship Program is for women and men who:

- ♦ are between 22-35 years-old
- ♦ have two to five years of full-time work experience in the public sector, civil society sector or research institution/academia
- ♦ have a first university degree
